Thank you for volunteering at St. Agnes Parish and School

St. Agnes Parish and School follow the Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program (Protecting God's Children). The program is designed to help protect the youth, elderly, and vulnerable adults of our parish as they participate in activities within our community. This process also provides a layer of protection against the possibility of false accusations for those adults who are involved in our ministries.

All employees and volunteers who work with children and vulnerable adults must be in full compliance with the Safe Environment Program before they are able to work or volunteer. This includes:

- Fill out the **Workers Registration Form** and undergo a background check updated in even-numbered years with the FCSR.

- If you have lived outside Missouri within the past five years filling out the **American Checked Waiver-Out of State Background Check form**.

If you wish to volunteer and are still in high school or under 18 years old, please read and sign the **Code of Ethical Conduct for Youth** form and return it to Patricia Roehr in the school office.
